**Specific Exclusions**

**Examples**

<b>Antirheumatic injectables</b>	<i>Enbrel</i>
<b>Botulinum toxin</b>	<i>Botox, Mylobloc</i>
<b>Compounded medications for infusion</b> <i>active medication containing more than one ingredient</i>	
<b>Gonadotropin</b>	
<b>Finasteride (Propecia)</b> <i>approved for prostate disorders only</i>	
<b>Hyaluronic acid derivatives</b>	<i>Hyalgan, Synvisc</i>
<b>Immune globulin intravenous (IGIV)</b>	<i>Sandoglobulin, Venoglobulin</i>
<b>Injectable muscle relaxants</b>	<i>Lioresal</i>
<b>Mifepristone</b>	
<b>Minoxidil (Rogaine)</b>	
<b>Monoclonal antibodies</b>	<i>Remicade, Synagis</i>
<b>Propoxyphene</b>	
<b>Recombinant human growth hormone (HGH)</b>	<i>Geref, Humatrope</i>

**Class Exclusions**

<b>Durable Medical Equipment*</b>	<i>Test strips; Lancets</i>
<b>Cosmetic Medications</b>	
<b>Erectile Dysfunction Pharmaceuticals</b>	<i>Viagra, Levitra, Cialis, Caverject</i>
<b>Fertility Drugs</b>	
<b>Herbal Medications</b>	
<b>Immunizing Biologicals</b>
